On Thursday, March 14, 2013, the Board of Trustees of Nimishillen Township met in regular session at 7:00 PM at the Nimishillen Township Hall located at 4422 Maplegrove NE with the following members present: Trustee President Michael L. ### **CITIZENS:**

O David Pumneo, 7476 Brookside Street – stepped to podium and said his land backs up to the road known as the 'common road'. He was disappointed when Trustee Lynch reported there is still no solution to the problem. Mr. Lynch and Mr. Riggenbach met with Stark County Prosecutor Mike Bickis. They are still saying the township does not have any legal rights in regards to the 'common road'. If no one owns the 'common road', the neighbor who has been making changes should not do so – it's not her road. Mr. Pumneo also spoke about some of the neighbors who continue to make life unpleasant for the residents who live on Brookside.

**TRUSTEES:** (Mike Lynch, Lisa Shafer)

Members from Louisville Board of Education will be guest speakers at April 11<sup>th</sup> Trustees' meeting: At the last trustees' meeting, some residents felt they needed more information and answers about the school levy that will be on the May 7<sup>th</sup> ballot (Issue #12). Trustee Lynch said members from the Louisville Board of Education will be guest speakers at the trustees' April 11<sup>th</sup> meeting @ 7 PM to discuss and answer residents' questions/concerns regarding the necessity of the Emergency Operating Levy for Louisville Schools. As always, the meeting is open to the public.

<u>Nimishillen Creek Sec. 729 Watershed Assessment Study</u>: There were concerns last summer in regards to excess water wanting to follow the waterway path. Trustee Lynch said the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District will do a study of East Nimishillen Creek in the future which will result in a Compressive Watershed Management Plan for the Nimishillen Creek Watershed. The Muskingum Watershed Conservancy Dist. and Army Corps of Engineers are trying to find a way to help eliminate some of the problems that happen when excess water follows the waterway path.
