7:00 PM – Regular Meeting:

Trustee Shafer called the meeting to order and led the staff and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Lynch gave the Invocation.

Trustee Shafer excused Trustee Johnson from tonight's meeting.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: (Rich Peterson, Chief)
