On Thursday, August 11, 2016, the Board of Trustees of Nimishillen Township met in regular session at 7:00 PM at the Nimishillen Township Hall located at 4422 Maplegrove NE with the following members present: Trustee President Lisa R. Shafer, Trustee Vice President Michael L. Lynch, Trustee Todd D. Bosley, and Fiscal Officer, Brian Kandel.

Trustee Shafer called the meeting to order and led the staff and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Lynch gave the invocation.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: (Rich Peterson, Chief)

Discussion – Chief Peterson informed the Board that the Emergency Medical Dispatcher training course has been completed, which was held at Fire Station #3. This course allows dispatchers to give medical direction. There were 5 township dispatchers in attendance as well as other dispatchers outside of Stark County.

Discussion – Chief Peterson informed the Board that the Firefighter Association Fundraiser will be on Saturday, September 17 from 4 - 7 at Bud's Corner. There will be a pig roast and drawings. Tickets are \$25 and the revenue is used to send kids to burn camp and for the smoke detectors. Trustee Bosley encouraged the Board to donate to the fundraiser.
